OPG WINTER FESTIVAL OF LIGHTS – NEW PART 2 - WINTER WONDERLAND UNTIL FEBRUARY 21, 2022

The 39th Ontario Power Generation (OPG) Winter Festival of Lights in Niagara Falls, Canada's famous free outdoor light festival, has transitioned into a <u>Winter Wonderland</u> as this inaugural Part 2 of the Festival continues with a focus on winter- and love-themed displays until February 21, 2022. The frozen twinkle of Niagara Falls is always a breathtaking sight. The new Winter Wonderland theme gives visitors another reason to enjoy the breathtaking magic of the frozen winter season in Niagara Falls. Displays are rearranged and in new locations. NEW - NIAGARA PARKS POWER STATION TAILRACE TUNNEL

JULY 1, 2022

Following the completion and opening of Phase 1 in 2021, Niagara Parks will launch Phase 2 of this new landmark attraction just south of the Horseshoe Falls in Niagara Falls on July 1, 2022. By day, visitors can explore the preserved interior of the historic power station, transformed with new exhibits and guest amenities, while each night, CURRENTS, an immersive sound & light experience brings the building to life through state-of-the-art projection mapping technology. Phase 2 of the adaptive reuse project will invite visitors to explore the vast underground portions of the Power Station as they travel down nearly 200 feet below the main floor via glass enclosed elevator to reach the tailrace tunnel which connects the plant to the Niagara River. Visitors will make their way through the enormous, century old tunnel, brought to life with projection mapping technology to emerge beside the base of the Horseshoe Falls.

NEW - NIAGARA FALLS eXCHANGE (NFX) CULTURAL HUB & MARKET JULY 2022

The new Niagara Falls Cultural Hub & Market will become a vibrant cultural and social centre of activity in Niagara Falls by providing shared spaces where artists, musicians, food vendors and patrons, and local businesses can come together and create. Located in the historic Main and Ferry district, it will include a large culture and market hall, café, artist studios, creative workshop and public washrooms surrounded by two multifunctional civic plazas that interconnect the flanking streets. The Market Hall, which will house the regularly scheduled Farmers' Market, will be a space for other events that include music, theatre, lectures and other weekend markets. Located adjacent to the Niagara Falls History Museum, the site is knit together with a design language that prioritizes an accessible public realm and creates quality indoor and outdoor space that is durable, flexible, and sustainable. The project name - Niagara Falls Exchange (NFX), speaks to the rich exchange of ideas and creativity that is anticipated to occur on site and between the arts and culture, food and farming communities of Niagara Falls. Designed by DTAH, an award-winning architecture, landscape architecture and urban design firm, construction began September 2020. <u>Video</u> More information here

NIAGARA FALLS CONVENTION CENTRE RENAMED TO CELEBRATE ICONIC DESTINATION

Kicking off 2022, Niagara Falls Canada's landmark event, meeting and convention venue begins its second decade as the **Niagara Falls Convention Centre** (formerly Scotiabank Convention Centre). The new name honours its iconic destination and Niagara Falls' coveted reputation as one of Canada's top international meeting and convention destinations.

Opened in 2011, the Niagara Falls Convention Centre (NFCC) is the Niagara region's largest meeting and event venue with over 300,000 sq ft of flexible space. The NFCC is located within the Fallsview Entertainment District, only 250 steps away from the majestic Falls themselves and walking distance to more than 4,000 hotel rooms.

An important economic and cultural center for the city, over the last decade the NFCC has hosted thousands of international and national conventions, meetings, concerts and events including the Assembly of First Nations, the Federation of Canadian Municipalities, national and provincial political conventions and countless national corporate and association events as well as the Niagara Falls Comic Con. The versatile space has acted as a film and television studio and most recently as a major vaccination location for the community. With all that Niagara Falls offers, the NFCC attracts repeat events where gathering in the city becomes an eagerly anticipated annual tradition for many organizations. FEBRUARY IS BLACK HISTORY MONTH

Niagara Falls, Ontario holds a place in history as one of the final destinations of the renowned 'Underground Railroad', a secret network of routes that freedom seekers followed from the United States to freedom in Canada arriving in Fort Erie, Niagara Falls and on to Niagara-on-the-Lake. It is estimated that 30,000-40,000 freedom seekers escaped into Canada from the US from 1800-1865. Among those who escaped to Canada was a heroine named <u>Harriet Tubman</u> who made 13 return trips to liberate others through the Underground Railroad between 1852 and 1857. <u>Burr Plato</u> also escaped to Canada where we he went on to become a prosperous businessman and politician in local government and had property acquisitions on what is now Stanley Avenue in Niagara Falls.

For those who wish to retrace the final steps of the thousands who found freedom in Canada and pay homage to the heroes and heroines who helped them, <u>here</u> are some ways to explore the region.

BIRDS ON THE NIAGARA, INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL AND CELEBRATION

February 10 – 12, 2022

With its proximity to the Niagara River corridor, one of the world's most biodiverse places, Niagara Falls is a four-season destination for bird lovers, adventure travelers and ecotourists alike. Over 170 bird species including 27 species of gulls, many of them rare, have been found here making it the best gull watching location in the world and a top destination for birders from all over the world hoping to add them to their list.

Over 100,000 birds can be found along the Niagara River's Globally Significant Bird Area on any given winter day. Learn about Niagara's native bird species, from their unique voices, plumage patterns, colours and antics! Get a rare opportunity to see a red-tailed hawk, a great horned owl and a bald eagle.
